HEAVY RAIN LASHES STATE

T'Puram: North and central parts of the state received heavy rainfall on Monday even as Met officials warned of heavy to very heavy rainfall in several parts of the districts in the days ahead. Southern districts, including Thiruvananthapuram, also received copious rainfall with the southwest monsoon strengthening after a brief lull in the region. The monsoon calamities control room in the state capital reported no untoward incidents on Monday. Vythiri (11 cm), Vaikom (10 cm) and Palakkad and Chittur (9 cm) received the highest amount of rainfall till Monday morning. Mananthavady, Ottapalam, Parambikulam, Manjeri and Ambalavayal in northern Kerala and Idukki and Munnar in the central part of the state also received copious rainfall on Monday. The latest IMD forecasts warn most districts would receive heavy rainfall till July 13. The northern districts of Kozhikode, Kannur, Kasargod and Wayanad would receive heavy to very heavy rainfall between July 11 and July 13.
