Caste-based discrimination alleged at relief camp

THE police have started an investigation after a group of people belonging to Dalit community alleged caste-based discrimination at a flood relief camp in Pallippad panchayat, near here. The police registered a case under various sections of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Cribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act against 20 people on Monday.

The Kayamkulam DySP will conduct an inquiry into the incident. The members of the Dalit community registered a complaint with Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan and District Collector S Suhas, alleging that members of the Christian community had humilated them at a relief camp at Anjilimoodu LP School. The District Collector has ordered a probe into the complaint.

Minister flays relief camp inmate
