## Idukki, Cheruthonni Dam, Shutters Closed

## TW/O SHUTTERS OF CHIERUTHONY DAM CLOSED

**Idukki.i:** As water level in Idukki dam receded for the third cconsecutive day on Monday, government and KSEB'ss dam safety wing reduced the level of water being released from the dam and closed two shutters of Cheruthony dam in the evening. Water level in the dam att 7pm on Monday was 2,397.04ft, compared to 2,398.668ft on Sunday evening.

"Pr'resently, 750 cumecs (cubic m/sec) is being releaséed. Since water level in the reservoir has reached safe leevels, we reduced the flow to 300 cumecs. Inflow to the i dam is 590 cumecs and 750 cumecs is used for power r generation. Rain in dam's catchment area is coming down," said KSEB executive engineer (dam safetyy) VS Balu. However, water level in Mattupetty dam h/las reached 1,599m and its total storage capacity is 1,5999.6m. When water level reaches 1599.59m, shutteers will be opened," he said.

Me eanwhile, water level in Mullaperiyar dam rose to 135.4ftft on Monday noon. During the past 24 hours, Idukki i recorded an average rainfall of 66.3mm.

Meleanwhile due to heavy rain, landslide occurred at Chemrimannar and Vadakkekavala near Rajakkad on Sunda'ay night, destroying acres of agri land owned by Vazha'achalil Sojan from Rajakkad. Another landslide was re'eported at Chemmannar on Saturday night, destro'oying acres of plants, besides Chemmannar -Nedummkandam road, said residents. District collector Jeevann Babu K directed various departments to collect the deletails of causalities in the district within a week. "In thele present situation, traffic won't be allowed on Cherututhony bridge. It will resume after a safety inspecaction," he said.

In 1 18 relief camps, 1,430 people from 471 families are stataying, said officials. The collector reviewed arranggements and interacted with people. Idukki MP Joice C George visited Mankulam. TNN
