Idukki: Water level in Idukki reservoir receded for the second day from 2,400.6ft on Saturday evening to 2,398.68ft on Sunday evening. But, heavy rain con-tinued in the catchment areas of the reservoir on Sunday.Meanwhile, water level in Mullaperiyardam rose to 135.2ft on Sunday morning. Over the past 24 hours, Idukki recorded an average rainfall of 20.86mm 20.86mm.
